The ladder sustained some damage but the shore facility was undamaged. At the time of the ship's departure, the gangway had not been stowed completely. Gangway repairs are to be effected at a later port.

4/07/11	MA201100052	15:35	UTC+10	No	Bell Bay No 6 berth	Crimson Venus	IMO No	9134177	Contact	At about 1535 the weather deteriorated in Bell Bay with wind gusting to about 40-50 knots. Crimson Venus's headlines were slacked off but at about 1545 one of the headlines parted. The ship was then blown off the wharf. The wharf loader was positioned over number six hold and as the ship moved off the wharf the loader made contact with the forward hatch cover of number six hold. The loader sustained minor damage.

Section 48 of the Act contains a definition for an OBR. The voice component of a Voyage Data Recorder normally meets the requirements of an OBR.

Part 6 Division 1 of the TSI Act provides for certain confidentiality protections which must be applied to OBRs. Where an OBR is declared not to be an OBR other protections may continue to apply such as those relating to personal information under privacy legislation.
