14/10/2015	MA201500145	15:02	UTC+9.5	No	At Sea 25NM north of Darwin	FIONA F	IMO No	9600475	Flooding	Whilst shipping seas over the main deck during the return leg of a stores delivery to an offshore facility, the vessel suffered loss of watertight integrity through a leaking deck hatch leading to the steering compartment. The hatch seal was repaired en route to harbour, the water ingress discharged, and the vessel returned safely to Darwin without further incident.

Note: For the purpose of subsection 49(2) of the Transport Safety Investigation Act 2003 (TSI Act) any On-Board Recordings (OBR) relating to a matter that the ATSB has decided not to investigate, as identified in this publication, are not to be treated as OBR on and after the date of publication of this weekly summary.

Section 48 of the TSI Act contains a definition of an OBR. The voice component of a Voyage Data Recorder normally meets the requirements of an OBR.

Part 6 Division 1 of the TSI Act provides for certain confidentiality protections which must be applied to OBR. When an OBR is declared not to be an OBR other protections may continue to apply such as those relating to personal information under privacy legislation.
