The harbour tugs which had just cast off reattached the tow lines to assist the vessel while repairs were conducted by the crew. Passage was resumed two hours later.
06/07/2020	MA202000314	13:00	UTC+10	No	Gladstone	Bright Imabari	IMO No	9801316	Machinery failure	While preparing to depart the anchorage, the crew received a main engine alarm. The ship's engineers inspected the engine and found an oil leak from the turbocharger. The vessel remained at anchor to allow repairs to be conducted by the crew.
07/07/2020	MA202000310	1:42	UTC+10	No	3 NM ESE Caloundra	Cosco Indonesia	IMO No	9448786	Machinery failure	While conducting main engine tests prior to entering port, the main engine failed. The vessel went to anchor while repairs were conducted by the crew and passage resumed 5 hours later.

Note: For the purpose of subsection 49(2) of the Transport Safety Investigation Act 2003 (TSI Act) any On-Board Recordings (OBR) relating to a matter that the ATSB has decided not to investigate, as identified in this publication, are not to be treated as OBR on and after the date of publication of this weekly summary.

Section 48 of the TSI Act contains a definition of an OBR. The voice component of a Voyage Data Recorder normally meets the requirements of an OBR.

Part 6 Division 1 of the TSI Act provides for certain confidentiality protections which must be applied to OBR. When an OBR is declared not to be an OBR other protections may continue to apply such as those relating to personal information under privacy legislation.
