As per my phone call earlier today, please find attached a number of photos of the aircraft and surrounds.

Image 5897 is taken facing the direction of travel of the aircraft. The fence post in the centre-foreground was struck by the right hand horizontal stabiliser which is shown in Image 5909.

The left hand extremity of the left hand horizontal stabiliser also clipped a wooden fence post which tore a piece of the stabiliser off the aircraft.

Image 5903 and 5904 show the scrape marks on the face of the propeller blades and their damage.






